ARMTA began in 1932 out of a love for music and a desire to promote its instruction. Our members are teachers of Music and Speech Arts who have undergone extensive education and a comprehensive screening process. The branch board incorporated the Endowment Society in 1987 as a registered charity. The main goal is to fund scholarships that reward and support students of ARMTA Calgary Branch teachers. Those teachers directly impact the lives of over 5,000 Calgary and area students.

The students being presented with awards today received the three highest marks in each discipline category. Each achieved a mark of 87% or higher on their exams - the highest score earned this year was 96! Fourth place piano scholarships will be presented for Honourable Mention next month at the Outstanding Student Recital (OSR).






## Named Scholarships

**Maestoso & Prestissimo Scholarships** In 2025, ARMTA Calgary Branch established these two scholarships, named in alignment with the titles of our top sponsorship tiers, Maestoso and Prestissimo. In the event that we acquire advertisers at one or both of these levels, their business name(s) will be added to the scholarship names. These two scholarships are open to piano students at Levels 9, 10, and ARCT. The \$150 Maestoso scholarship will be presented to the student with the second highest aggregate score on a) the practical exam mark, b) the co-requisite Harmony exam mark and c) the co-requisite History exam mark. The \$100 Prestissimo scholarship will be presented to the student with the third highest score.

**Yamaha Scholarship (Maestoso)** We are pleased to welcome our top advertiser to the ARMTA Calgary Recital & Awards (ACRA)!

**Piano Performance Collective Scholarship** Beginning with the 2024 ACRA, this \$200 scholarship is open to piano students at Levels 9, 10, and ARCT. It is presented to the student with the highest aggregate score on a) the practical exam mark, b) the co-requisite Harmony exam mark and c) the co-requisite History exam mark. The scholarship continues a tradition that began with the Piano Diploma Association's Scholarship of a similar nature.

**The Peter Turner Memorial Scholarship** of \$100 is awarded to the student who has earned the highest mark in the ARCT Performance Examination during the past year. Peter Turner was a highly regarded teacher of piano for many years in Calgary. His students played at the highest level and were consistently successful not only in local but also national competitions. Peter Turner set a high standard for both his students and for other teachers, and he was also a senior examiner for the Royal Conservatory of Music. Peter passed away in 2008.
